River Nile	A river, which flows through the continent of Africa. It is the <b>longest river in the world</b>
Black Land	The <b>land either side of the River Nile</b> , which is black in colour. It is full of rich nutrients to help plants grow
Irrigation	The <b>supply of water</b> , which helps land or crops, grow
Archaeologist	Scientists who <b>study the history of humans</b> by looking at what has been left behind (e.g. objects buried underground or graves)
Pharaohs	Pharaohs were the <b>Kings or Queens of Egypt</b> . A Pharaoh was the most important and powerful person in kingdom
Artefacts	An object made and <b>used a long time ago</b>
Hieroglyphics	An Ancient Egyptian writing system
Mummification	The process used by Ancient Egyptians to <b>preserve a person's body for the afterlife</b>
Pyramid	A <b>huge stone tomb</b> build by Ancient Egyptians
