<b>Week 1</b>	<p><b>To know that the Romans were an ancient civilisation</b></p> <p>The Romans had an empire.</p> <p>The Romans used their technology and large army to explore and rule their empire.</p> <p>People living in Britain were not as advanced as the Romans.</p>	<p><b>To identify the location of Egypt and understand the importance of the Nile</b></p> <p>Egypt is located in north-east Africa.</p> <p>The River Nile floods, which creates fertile land for farming.</p> <p>Ancient Egyptians lived near the Nile as they could grow food.</p>	<p><b>To know that Gandhi is remembered as a significant person in history for his peaceful protests</b></p> <p>When Gandhi was alive, India was ruled as part of the British Empire.</p> <p>Gandhi wanted India to rule itself Gandhi is known as 'Mahatma' meaning 'great soul' and remembered for his peaceful protests.</p>
<b>Week 2</b>	<p><b>To know that the Romans had several large armies with many soldiers from around the Empire</b></p> <p>The Roman army was large and well organized.</p> <p>Roman soldiers wore armour and carried weapons.</p> <p>Roman soldiers were well trained and this helped the Roman Army to conquer much of Europe.</p>	<p><b>To understand that Ancient Egyptian society was hierarchical</b></p> <p>Pharaohs were Ancient Egyptian rulers.</p> <p>Farmers were at the bottom of the social pyramid.</p> <p>Archaeologists use artefacts and the remains of villages to find out about Ancient Egypt.</p>	<p><b>To know that Rosa Parks and Martin Luther King fought for equal rights for black people in America</b></p> <p>Rosa Parks was arrested for refusing to give up her seat to a white man on a public bus.</p> <p>Rosa Park's arrest led to the Montgomery Bus Boycott, led by Martin Luther King.</p> <p>Martin Luther King led the Civil Rights Movement in America and gave powerful speeches.</p>
<b>Week 3</b>	<p><b>To know that the Romans invaded Britain</b></p> <p>The Romans successfully invaded Britain in 43 CE.</p> <p>Boudicca rebelled against the Romans.</p> <p>Boudicca's rebellion was unsuccessful.</p>	<p><b>To know that Ancient Egyptians worshipped many gods and believed in the afterlife</b></p> <p>Ancient Egyptians worshipped over 2000 gods and goddesses.</p> <p>Ancient Egyptians believe Pharaohs represented Gods on Earth.</p> <p>They believed in the afterlife.</p>	<p><b>To know that Malala Yousafzai stood up for girls and their right to education even when it was dangerous to do so</b></p> <p>When the Taliban took control Swat Valley in Pakistan, they banned girls from going to school.</p> <p>Malala Yousafzai spoke out publicly on behalf of girls and their right to learn.</p> <p>Malala Yousafzai set up a charity to help girls and won a Nobel Peace Prize.</p>
<b>Week 4</b>	<p><b>To know that Romans built towns across Britain</b></p> <p>The Romans built towns surrounded by stone walls.</p> <p>Roman towns often contained shops, homes, yards for animals, a forum and a basilica.</p> <p>Hadrian's Wall formed the northern border of the Roman Empire.</p>	<p><b>To know that Howard Carter discovered the tomb of Tutankhamun</b></p> <p>Tutankhamun became Pharaoh at 9 when his father died.</p> <p>An archaeologist, Howard Carter discovered Tutankhamun's tomb.</p> <p>Tutankhamun was mummified and was surrounded by lots of priceless treasures.</p>	<p><b>To know that Greta Thunberg is a young, environmental activist</b></p> <p>Greta Thunberg raised awareness for Climate Change by going on strike from school on Fridays.</p> <p>Greta speaks at important events and tries to convince people to change their behaviours to help save the planet.</p> <p>Greta has Asperger's Syndrome and raises awareness for people with neurodiversity.</p>
<b>Week 5</b>	<p><b>To know that the Romans made changes to Britain</b></p> <p>The Romans built towns and roads across Britain.</p> <p>The Romans created written records which is how we know about their history.</p> <p>After the fall of the Roman Empire, many people and aspects of Roman life remained in Britain.</p>	<p><b>To understand that hieroglyphics can tell us about life in Ancient Egypt</b></p> <p>Ancient Egyptians left pictures, writing and statues behind.</p> <p>Hieroglyphics can tell us about life in Ancient Egypt.</p> <p>The Rosetta Stone helped people understand hieroglyphics.</p>	<p><b>To know David Attenborough is a British broadcaster who makes natural history documentaries and speaks out about taking care of our planet</b></p> <p>David Attenborough has made lots of natural history documentaries teaching people about the planet earth.</p> <p>David Attenborough speaks out about Climate Change and asks people to take care of the earth.</p> <p>The first electronic TV was invented in 1927 but it wasn't until the 1970s that most homes in Britain had a television.</p>
